SIDEWALK PROGRAM:

The purpose of this application is for the applicant to be considered for reimbursement in conjunction with the City of Burlington's Sidewalk Program. This program is intended to assist the applicant with the cost of replacing all or a portion of their existing sidewalk or installing a new sidewalk.

Once the application has been submitted to the Community Development Department, the sidewalk will be scored. Sidewalks are scored based on their necessity of replacement; taking into account the location near busy streets and public places (parks, schools, etc), connectivity to other sidewalks, and hazardous conditions of existing sidewalks. Not all applications will be funded due to the limited amount of funds available. The City will reimburse the sidewalks that are scored the highest (in most need) and will proceed based on the amount of funding available.

The City will reimburse those selected at a rate of \$4.00 per running foot upon completion and approval of the work. All sidewalk installation or replacement shall be done according to the City of Burlington's Sidewalk Regulations and Design Standards and all applicants must insure that proper safety precautions are taken during this work (ie signage, barricades, etc). If the project intersects a street, a handicap ramp must be installed.

This reimbursement is not to be considered to fund the entire project; this program is designed to assist the applicant by reimbursing a portion of the cost incurred. The applicant is responsible to pay the contractor in full for the completed sidewalk improvements and should anticipate reimbursement from the City (at the rate of \$4.00 per running foot) within 30 calendar days after final acceptance of the work by the City.

Sidewalk regulations are found under Chapter 137 of the Burlington Municipal Code.

- x Application deadline for the 1st round of funding is June 2, 2008. Applicants that are approved for funding will be notified of approval beginning on July 7, 2008.***
- x Applications that are received after June 2, 2008 will be considered based on remaining funding and will be notified of approval in Fall 2008.***

A drawing and photograph shall accompany this application. These shall outline the dimensions of the work and shall show the condition of the current sidewalk.

TO BE CONSIDERED FOR THIS PROGRAM, NO CONSTRUCTION SHALL BEGIN BEFORE APPROVAL IS GIVEN AND THE PERMIT IS ISSUED BY THE CITY.
