



PERMITTED HOME OCCUPATION

Permitted Home Occupations are allowed in any district that allows household living, provided that they are registered with the Development Department. The Home Occupation should not alter the normal residential characteristic of the premises, and in no way cause a nuisance to the surrounding properties and neighborhood. Regulations for Home Occupations can be found under *Chapter 17.30.40 Home Occupations* of the Zoning and Subdivision Code for the City of Burlington, Iowa.
